What is student workload?

The workload of a course is the time a student needs to efficiently study a curriculum and complete a set of course activities.

The workload includes both scheduled activities & study time outside class, as well as time spent thinking through the course material.

Rules of thumb for workload estimation

reading ————	———— 7 pages/hour
reflective writing ————	250 words/hour
argumentative writing ————	125 words/hour
watching video —————	3 x [video length]
Zoom/Teams call ———————	——— 15 min + [call length]
reading PowerPoint slides ————	20 slides/hour
quiz problems —————	——— 10 questions/hour
processing lecture ————	$ 0.5 \times [lecture length]$

The estimation of the workload helps to make sure students have a realistic chance to achieve the intended learning outcomes.

This can be communicated to students by using infographics in the syllabus of the course on Brightspace and during the first session of the course.
